(I'm just using "getc" instead of "goto" because I don't want to open the 'goto' file.) A:

Finally figured it out after reading this answer: In my.vimrc, I added this line: `nnoremap :call search('^[0-9]', 'n')` I realize that it's not a 'bind' but it's the simplest way I've found to disable these auto-corrections in this type of configuration, and it works. I'm still not sure if there's a more elegant way, such as using a 'bind' that uses "getc", but I doubt there is

I have a link with an on click event. `$.get(.....)` On the other hand, I have a document ready that waits for the data to load. When the data loading is done then the page returns.
